## Chinese Team Receives Training on Fish Disease Control and Management

A group of seven fish disease specialists from the China National Extension Center for Fisheries Technology - one of USSEC's major cooperators in China - traveled to the U.S. for a special training program on fish disease control and management at Louisiana State University. During the training, team members attended lectures on fish disease diagnosis, had hands-on experience using different lab techniques, visited two research institutes, and one fish and one shrimp production facility. All the team members agreed that this was a very successful training program, which will definitely help them improve fish disease management in China.
